## MFSM Application Eligibility Criteria

- 1. TACC exists for the sole purpose of helping children up to and including the age of 18.
- 2. Consideration for MFSM opportunities will be given to children up to the age of 18 years who are disadvantaged by disability, poverty, education, violence and/or lifestyle.
- 3. TACC reserves the right to consider all applications individually and on their own merit.
- 4. Favourable consideration will be given to those applications which directly benefit a number/large number of children and/or positively increase the quality of their lives.
- 5. Applications can be submitted at any time. TACC trustees discuss applications at regular intervals and will reply to successful and unsuccessful applications shortly within 4 weeks of receipt of application.

## MFSM Application Information and Process

- Each successful applicant will receive a match ticket and in addition each child will receive
  - A new Scotland football shirt
  - A small Scotland saltire flag
  - £12.50 pocket money
- If successful, you will be sent a second form to provide details of the child/children attending including name, age and shirt size. Also the contact details of the supervisors attending the match with the child/children plus the contact details of the person responsible for distributing the packages to each child. Only when the sizes are obtained will the shirts be ordered.
- Note "My First Scotland Match" operates for both men's and women's matches (usually at Hampden Park Glasgow). If you are offered a women's match and you decline it, your group will go to the back of the queue.



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
